How the Color Battle fundraiser works:

- 1) Log on to Anython.com - Students will receive their own unique access code.
- 2) Help connect your students to potential donors - Use the Share Wizard on your students Anython.com donation page to share it through email, text, Facebook and Twitter and donors can enter and pay their donations online.
- 3) Or send cash/checks to school – Make all checks payable to Dowell Middle School.
- 4) **Students must raise a minimum of \$30 in total donations & have their Permission Form signed and turned in by Thursday, February 14th in order to participate in the Color Battle event on Friday, February 15th.**
- 5) Students earn prizes starting at \$30 in donations received.
- 6) All donations must be paid online, or cash/checks turned into the school by 10:00am on Friday, February 15th to participate in the Color Battle event. If your child is participating, please have them wear old shoes and pants that are ok if they get stained and bring a change of clothing for after the event.
