## **Terms & Conditions:**

- 1. Students accessing or using any web 2.0 tool are required to keep personal information out of their postings. Please refer to McKinney ISD's online AUP (Acceptable Use Policy).
- 2. Students will not share their user name or password with anyone other than their parents.
- 3. Students will not log in as another classmate.
- 4. Assignments using Web 2.0 tools are like any other assignment in school. Students, in the course of completing assignments are expected to abide by policies and procedures in the Student Handbook, including those policies regarding plagiarism and acceptable use of technology as a MISD student.
- Student work may be a forum for student expression. However, they are first and foremost a tool for learning. Refer to McKinney ISD AUP online.
- 6. Students shall not use the Internet, in connection with teacher assignments, to harass, discriminate or threaten the safety of others. If students receive a comment used in school that makes them feel uncomfortable or is not respectful, they must immediately report this to a teacher or administration, and must not respond to the comment.
- 7. Students accessing any tools from school using school equipment shall not download or install any software without permission, and shall not click on ads or competitions.
- 8. Web 2.0 tools are allowed within the classroom in accepted parameters, but does not imply an "entitlement of usage" by the student just because they have an account.
